PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Tengakhat College is situated in Tengakhat about 30 K.M. east of Dibrugarh Town and 17 K.M. West of Duliajan Oil Town. The college was established in 1967 at the initiative of a few eminent educationists and social workers of Tengakhat. The college was brought under the Deficit Grant-in-Aid system in 1986 and received UGC affiliation under 2 (f) and 12 (B) in 2007. The college was established with the objectives of imparting higher education of the students of the locality and surrounding villages and tea gardens. The college was accredited "Grade B" by NAAC in December, 2005 in 1st cycle. The college was accredited Grade B++ (CGPA 2.87) by NAAC in November, 2016 in the 2nd cycle.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Candidates seeking admission to the college either to H.S. or Degree classes have to apply only in the prescribed Admission Form which can be Downloaded from the link provided by the College. Duly completed application form must be accompanied by the following documents.

- i) Self-Attested copy of the mark sheet of last examination.
- (ii) Self-Attested copy of the pass certificate and character certificate.
- (iii) Self-Attested copy of the age proof certificate.
- (iv) Self-Attested copy of caste certificate.
- (v) Two recent passport size photographs.

Original documents should be produced for verification at the time of admission.



ADMISSION PROCEDURE

As per Govt. of Assam, there will be free admission for the students, whose parent's annual income is below 1 Lakh (One Lakh only). At the time of admission the students will have to produce valid annual income certificate. But all the students seeking admission will have to pay Library Fee, Sports Fee, and a minimum fee on miscellaneous ground. As per Govt. instruction the students seeking free admission, will have to produce a photo of self planting a tree. The student shall have to take care of that plant and reproduce it's photo if he/she seeks free admission next year.

A candidate selected for admission whose parent's annual income is above 1 Lakh must pay the necessary dues fixed by the Govt. of Assam on the specific date in the Bank account of the college.

The admission committee scrutinizes all the Admission Forms submitted by the candidates along with their testimonials and prepares the list for admission strictly on the basis of merit. A separate list on caste cum merit basis is made in accordance with the Reservation Quota System as per Govt. norms. A waiting list is also prepared and a vacant seat if any is filled up from the candidates in that list.

Degree students who are interested for major/honours courses in different subjects shall have to apply separately after admission.

A list of the provisionally selected candidates will also be displayed in the Notice Board.

Finally selected candidates shall have to get themselves admitted on the same day of interview on payment of prescribed fee.

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (CBCS)

The University Grant Commission (UGC) has initiated several measures to being equality, efficiency and excellence in the Higher academic standards and quality in higher education include innovation and improvements in curriculum, teaching learning process, examination and evaluation systems, besides governance and other matters.

Choice Based Credit System is a flexible system of learning 'credit' defines the quantum of contents/syllabus prescribed for a course and determines the number of hours of instruction required. This system permits to learn at their own pace and choose electives from a wide range of Elective courses offered by the University. Dibrugarh University is going to introduce Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) from the Academic Session 2019-2020.

As per instruction from the Dibrugarh University, Tengakhat College will implement the same from the said session.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The college has a well equipped library and a Reading Room with a repository of books and journals. The library functions from 9 AM to 4 PM every working day. Students may borrow books from the library against their library cards. Each Departments also have their own Departmental libraries.

COLLEGE HOSTEL

The college has a hostel for girls with capacity of 75 seats, which are allotted strictly on merit basis. The students must apply for hostel seats in a separate application form which is to be submitted to the college office along with the application form for hostel admission.



COLLEGE NSS

The college has established NSS wing in the year 1992. It is actively associated with various community services since its inception. A neighboring Village has been adopted by the NSS unit of the College. The NSS unit has 100 members. The unit frequently organizes Blood Donation Camps. Awareness Programme etc. There is a Red Ribbon Club which is a part of NSS unit under Assam AIDS Control society. This club also organizes various awareness programmes among the students as well as neighboring areas. The name of the Programme officer – Prof. Mridul Bonia.

COLLEGE NCC

The college has NCC (SD-SW) under 10th Assam Bn NCC, Dibrugarh. The enrollment Capacity of NCC is 70 cdts. The NCC cadets render their services in maintenance of college discipline since its inception. More than 28 NCC cadets have already been appointed in Govt. services till now. Capt. Jatindra Nath Gogoi is the Associate NCC Officer (ANO) of this College.

HEALTH AND SANITATION CLUB

Established in 2014 the Health and Sanitation Club of Tengakhat College is recognized by Dibrugarh University and also it is funded by UNICEFF to its various programme. The club has 100 active student members to conduct its various activities.

PSYCHOLOGICAL LABORATORY

The college has a well equipped psychological laboratory for the students in the Department of Education. The laboratory is upgraded with advanced laboratory equipments.

COMPUTER CENTRE & LABORATORY

The College has a developed computer centre. The centre has a well equipped computer laboratory with 50 computers. The computer centre is likely to be upgraded to a centre for computer studies where various short and long term programs are to be conducted for the benefit of the students. The centre is facilitated with internet access.

WOMEN CELL

The college has a women cell, affiliated to the Centre for Women studies, Dibrugarh University. It performs various tasks like organizing seminars, workshops, symposiums in collaboration with the local people. The aim and objective of the cell is to create awareness among girls of different spheres of life in the locality and encourage their active participation in society as well as in their life.

ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES

A regulation to provide measures for phohibiting, preventing and eliminating the scourge of ragging in Tengakhat College including any conduct by any student or students whether by verbal or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness to a fresher's or any other student, or indulging in rowdy or in disciplined activities by any student or students which cause or are likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student or asking any student to do any act, which such a student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such a fresher or any other student, with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student, in Tengakhat College and thereby, to provide for the healthy development, physically and psychologically of all students of the college.

What is Ragging: Any act resulting – (a)¬ Mental/Physical/Sexual Abuse, (b) Verbal Abuse, (c) Indecent Behaviors, (d) Undermining Human Dignity, (e) Financial Exploitation/Extortion, and (f) Any of use of force.

The institution shall punish a student found guilty of ragging after following the procedure and in the manner prescribed herein under:

- (a) **The Anti-Ragging Committee** of the institution shall take an appropriate decision, in regard to punish mentor otherwise, depending on the facts of each incident of ragging and nature and gravity of the incident of ragging established in the commendations of the Anit-Ragging Squad.
- (b) The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely;
 - 1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
 - **2.** Withholding/Withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
 - **3.** Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evolution process.
 - 4. Withholding results.
 - **5.** Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - **6.** Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
 - 7. Cancellation of admission.
 - **8.** Rustication from the institution for period ragging from one to four semesters.



INFORMATION AND CAREER GUIDANCE CELL (ICGC)

The College has an information and Career Guidance Cell for the benefit of the students. Students may approach the cells for counseling regarding academic, personal and career matters.

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has launched a scheme on Skill Development based higher education as part of college/university education, leading to Bachelor of Vocation Degree (B.Voc).

The innovative scheme provides a great opportunity for those students who have been deprived of higher education for getting skill-based, job-oriented degrees under the title "B.Voc" (Bachelor of Vocatoin). The uniqueness of the degree is such that it has multiple exit points with job opportunity at each stage. The course has 4 stages with 6 semesters.

Semester - 1 & 2 : Diploma Programme Semester - 3 & 4 : Advanced Diploma

Semester – 5 & 6 : B.Voc

Further they also become eligible to pursue postgraduate studies and research like M.Voc. & Ph.D.

Tengakhat College has been approved to start 2 programmes under KAUSHAL Kendra leading to B.Voc.

1. Office Automation & E-Services. 2. Automobile Maintenance & Repair. The courses have been identified based on the skill-gap study and the job opportunities in Assam.

Instead of class room centered formal education, the students under the Kaushal Kendra learn through hands on experience and internships in industry and business houses. Most reputed companies/Business firms are came forward to sign MoUs with the college for providing their expertise in administering the said courses. Suitable candidates will also have the opportunity of getting absorbed in the business units where they get training.
