COLLEGE OVERVIEW

Tengakhat College is situated in Tengakhat about 30 K.M. east of District Head Quarter and 17 K.M. West of Duliajan Oil Town. The college was established in 1967 at the initiative of a few eminent educationists and Social Workers of Tengakhat. The college was brought under the Deficit Grant-in-Aid system in 1986 and received UGC affiliation under 2 (f) and 12 (B) in 2007. The college was established with the objectives of imparting higher education for students of the locality and surrounding villages and tea gardens. The college was accredited "Grade B" by NAAC in December, 2005 in 1st cycle and Grade B++ (CGPA 2.87) by NAAC in November, 2016 in the 2nd cycle.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Candidates seeking admission to the college either to H.S. or Degree classes have to apply only in the prescribed Admission Form which can be downloaded from the link provided by the College. Duly completed application form must be accompanied by the following documents.

- Self-Attested copy of the mark sheet of last examination.
- (ii) Self-Attested copy of the pass certificate and character certificate.
- (iii) Self-Attested copy of the age proof certificate.
- (iv) Self-Attested copy of caste certificate.
- (v) Two recent passport size photographs.

Original documents should be produced for verification at the time of admission.



ADMISSION PROCEDURE INTO VARIOUS FOR YEAR UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMMES (FYUGP) FOR THE SESSION 2025-26

As per Govt. of Assam, there will be free admission for the students, whose parent's annual income is below 1 Lakh (One Lakh only). At the time of admission the students will have to produce valid annual income certificate. But all the students seeking admission will have to pay Library Fee, Sports Fee, and a minimum fee on miscellaneous ground. As per Govt. instruction the students seeking free admission, will have to produce a photo of self planting a tree. The student shall have to take care of that plant and reproduce it's photo if he/she seeks free admission next year.

A candidate selected for admission whose parent's annual income is above 1 Lakh must pay the necessary dues fixed by the Govt. of Assam on the specific date in the Bank account of the college.

The admission committee scrutinizes all the Admission Forms submitted by the candidates along with their testimonials and prepares the list for admission strictly on the basis of merit. A separate list on caste cum merit basis is made in accordance with the Reservation Quota System as per Govt. norms. A waiting list is also prepared and if any vacant seat remains, it is filled up from the candidates in that list.

A list of the provisionally selected candidates will also be displayed in the Notice Board.

Finally selected candidates shall have to get themselves admitted on the same day of interview on payment of prescribed fee.

COLLEGE CANTEEN

The College has a canteen that provides hygienic foods of various kinds at a reasonable rate for students

CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM (FYUGP)

The University Grants Commission (UGC) has initiated NEP under the Samarth Portal to bring equality, efficiency and excellence in the Higher academic standards. Quality in higher education include innovation and improvements in curriculum, teaching learning process, examination and evaluation systems, besides governance and other matters.

FYUGP under NEP is a flexible system of earning 'credit'. It defines the quantum of contents/syllabus prescribed for a course and determines the number of hours of instruction required. This system permits to learn at their own space and choose electives from a wide range of Elective Courses offered by the University.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

The college has a well equipped library and a Reading Room with a repository of books and journals. The library functions from 9 AM to 4 PM every working day. Students can borrow books from the library against their library cards. Each Departments also have their own Departmental libraries.

COLLEGE HOSTEL

The college has a hostel for girls with capacity of 75 seats, which are allotted strictly on merit basis. The students must apply for hostel seats in a separate application form which is to be submitted to the college office along with the application form for hostel admission.

COLLEGE FISHERY

There is a sustainable fishery for raising and harvesting fishes and outsourcing it inside the college campus



COLLEGE NSS

The college has Introduced NSS wing in the year 1992. It is actively associated with various community services since its inception. A neighbouring Village has been adopted by the NSS unit of the College. The NSS unit has 100 members. The unit frequently organizes Blood Donation Camps. Awareness Programme etc. There is a Red Ribbon Club which is a part of NSS unit under Assam AIDS Control society. This club also organizes various awareness programmes among the students as well as neighbouring areas.

COLLEGE NCC

The college has NCC (SD-SW) under 10th Assam Bn NCC, Dibrugarh. The enrollment Capacity of NCC is 70 cdts. The NCC cadets render their services in maintaining discipline since its inception. Many NCC cadets have been appointed in Govt. services till now. Capt. Jatindranath Gogoi is the Associate NCC Officer (ANO) of this College.

HEALTH AND SANITATION CLUB

The Health and Sanitation Club of Tengakhat College is recognized by Dibrugarh University and it is funded by UNICEFF to its various programme. The club has 100 active student members to conduct its various activities, which was started in 2014.

PSYCHOLOGICAL LABORATORY

The college has a well equipped psychological laboratory for the students in the Department of Education. The laboratory is upgraded with advanced laboratory equipments.

COMPUTER CENTRE & LABORATORY

The College has developed a computer centre. The centre has a well equipped computer laboratory with 50 computers. The computer centre is likely to be upgraded to a centre for computer studies where various short and long term programs are to be conducted for the benefit of the students. The centre is facilitated with internet access.

WOMEN CELL

The University grants commission (UGC) has drafted guidelines to create a safe, secure and gender equitable environment in all higher educational institutions (HEIS) in the formation of various cells. The college has a women cell, which performs various tasks like organizing seminars, workshops, symposiums in collaboration with the local people. The aim and objective of the cell is to create awareness among girls of different spheres of life in the locality and encourage their active participation in society as well as in their life. There is a strong need to challenge the culture of silence that perpetuate the acts of violence against women, be it within the campus or outside.



RULES & REGULATION OF THE COLLEGE

- ⇒ Students must come to the College in proper uniform.
- Students should keep their Identity Card within College campus.
- Campus is strictly prohibited for any kind of Drug, Drinking Alcohol, Sewing Betel-nut, Pan-Supari, Gutkha and Smoking Bidi, Cigarette etc.
- Ragging is strictly prohibited.

- Decision of the College authority shall be final in case of any dispute.
- Hostel's boarder must maintain all the rules and regulations framed by the authority.
- Students should make habit to look into Notice Board regularly.

- Students must take interest in all types of co-curricular activities other than regular study.
- Students must attend all type of seminars, workshops, discussions held in time to time in the College..





ANTI-RAGGING MEASURES

A regulation is adopted to provide measures for phohibiting, preventing and eliminating the source of ragging from Tengakhat College. Any student or students who indulges in such act whether verbal or written abuse which is likely to cause annoyance, hardship or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof to any freshers or any other student which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche is strictly forbidden.

Ragging Free Campus: The following act falls under ragging:
(a) Mental/Physical/Sexual Abuse, (b) Verbal Abuse, (c) Indecent Behaviors, (d) Undermining Human Dignity, (e) Financial Exploitation/Extortion, and (f) Any use of force.

Ragging is totally banned in the college and anyone found guilty for ragging is liable to be punished as it is a punishable offence:

- (a) The Anti-Ragging Committee, In the observance of the orders issued by Hon'ble supreme court, stating that ragging is Prohibited in the educational institution in any form anti ragging committee is constituted in Tengakhat College.
- (b) The Anti-Ragging Committee, depending on the nature and seriousness of the guilt may take the following measures;
 - 1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
 - Withholding/Withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
 - Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evolution process.
 - Withholding results.
 - Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
 - Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
 - 7. Cancellation of admission.
 - 8. Rustication from the institution.



INFORMATION AND CAREER GUIDANCE CELL (ICGC)

The College has an information and Career Guidance Cell for the benefit of the students. Students may approach the cells for counseling regarding academic, personal and career matters.

DISTANCE EDUCATION CENTRE (Under Dibrugarh University & Krishna Kanta Handique state open University)

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship facilities are available only for ST/SC/OBC/MOBC Students. The scholarship could be received from the IDTP Dibrugarh after following the necessary procedure. Student can apply UGC-ISHAN UDAY Scholarship Scheme

GSCCSHC (Gender Sensitization Cell & College Sexual Harassment Cell)

In 1997 the supreme court recognized and addressed the issue of sexual harassment at the workplace.
