

Report on “Drug-Free India” Programme

On 13th August 2025, Tengakhat College, Dibrugarh, organised an event on the theme “Drug-Free India” to commemorate the 5th anniversary of the Nasha Mukta Bharat Abhiyaan, a nationwide campaign dedicated to eradicating drug abuse and fostering a healthier society.
